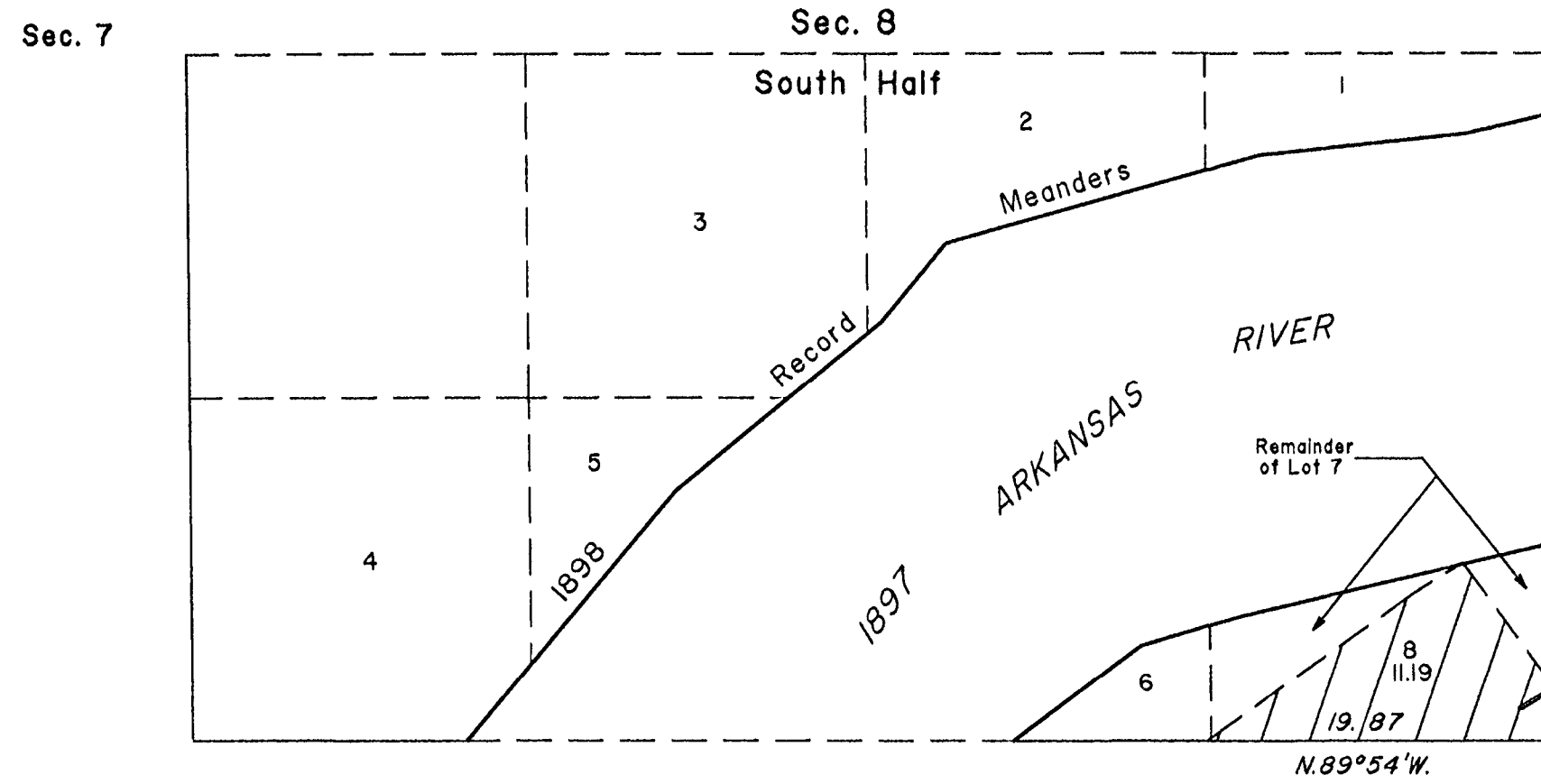
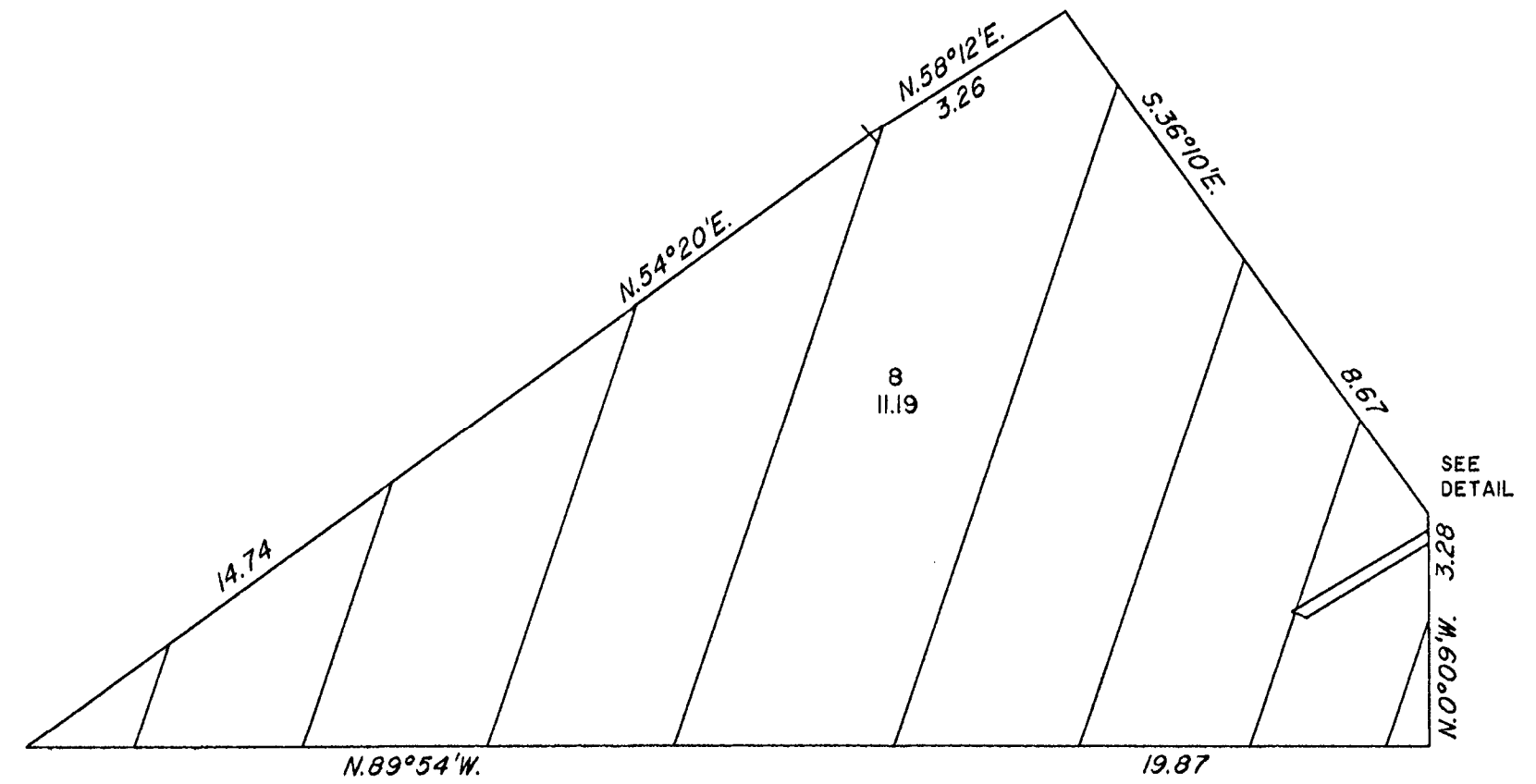


TOWNSHIP 10 NORTH, RANGE 24 EAST, OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN, OKLAHOMA

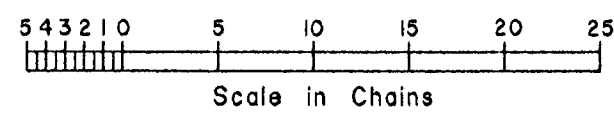


ENLARGED DIAGRAM

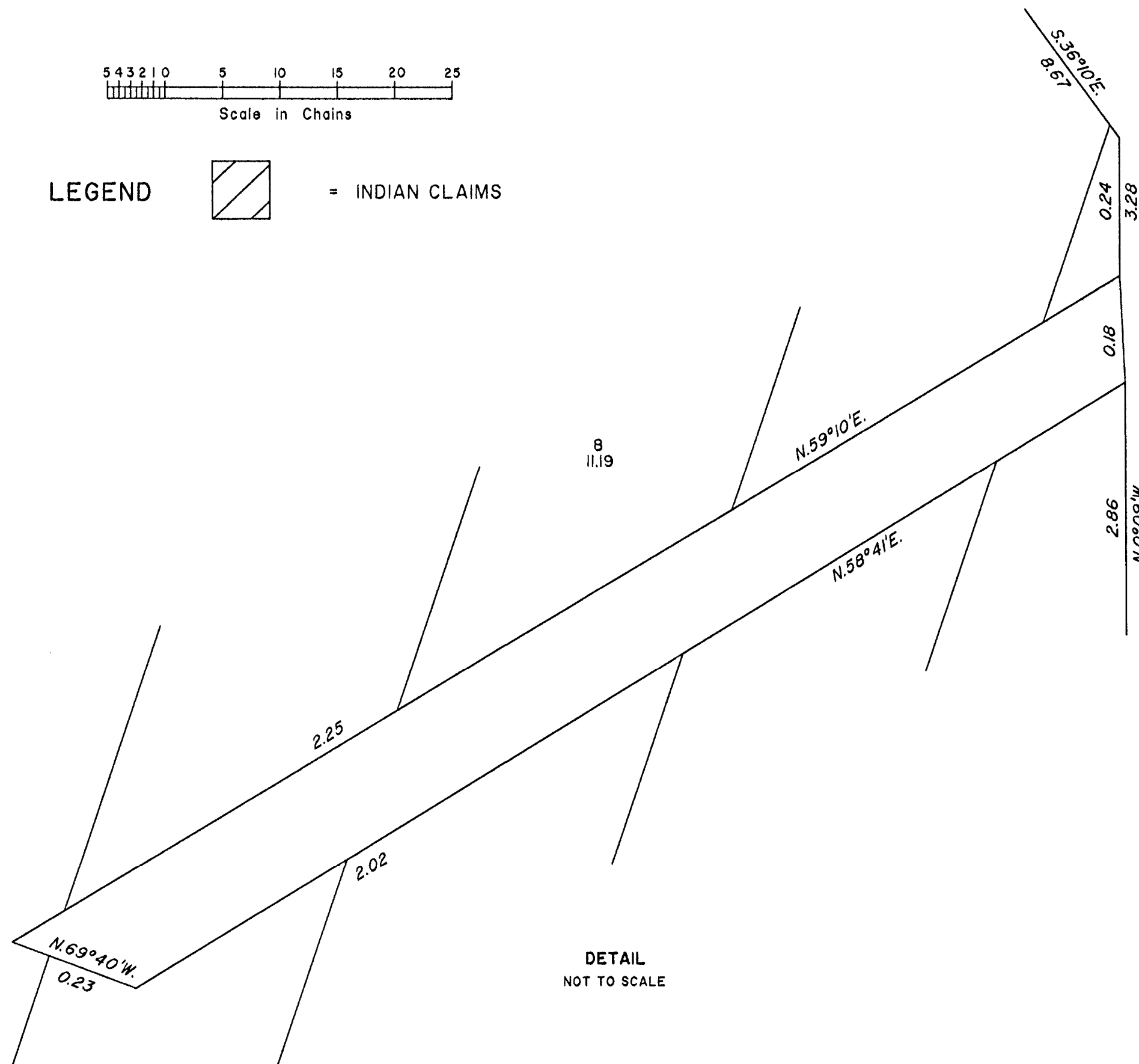
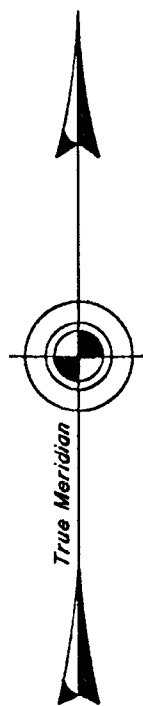

This supplemental plat, showing Indian Claims, is based on the plat approved November 1, 1898, and by examination of the best available evidence of river movements including historic aerial photography and maps. This evidence indicates the river moved southerly by accretive and erosive processes until 1966 after which the reservoir behind Kerr Dam covered both the upland and the riverbed areas in an avulsive action. Lot 8 is the only remaining portion of the 1966 riverbed not included with the disclaimed drybed lands in section 8.
