

A history of surveys and additional information are contained in the field notes.

This plat, in three sheets, represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary, a portion of the subdivisional lines, the 2010 adjusted record meanders of the 1897 right bank of the Arkansas River, and the informative traverse of the digitized 2003 right bank ordinary high water mark of the Arkansas River, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of sections, the metesand-bounds surveys, and accretions to certain lots, in sections 2, II, and I2, Township 9 North, Range 25 East, Indian Meridian, Oklahoma.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved November 2, 1898.

The intersections of the 2003 digitized right bank with surveyed lines were verified by this survey.
